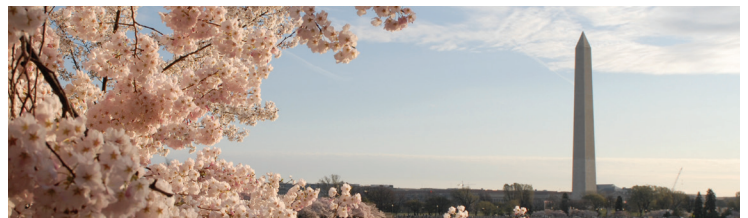

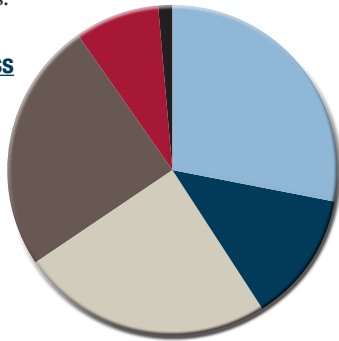


Employment Outcomes: Class of 2018
