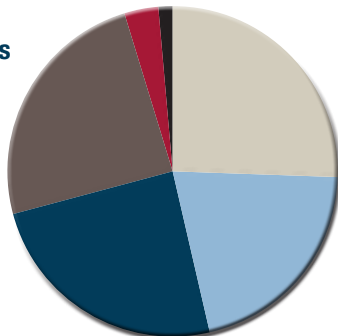
## CLASS OF 2020 EMPLOYMENT OUTCOMES
